2010 Olympic Scarf Pattern

Black with More Than Gold Stripes

Suggested Needles:

One pair needles size 5 1/2mm
Canadian size 5, American size 9)

Suggested Wool

Red Heart worsted medium wool
net weight - 198g (7oz)

Main Colour: Black

Other Colours: Small amounts (approx. 1 oz.) each of
Gold, Cherry Red, Kelly Green, Royal Blue, and
Purple.

Finished Measurements:

Width: 5 - 6 inches wide
Length: 6 feet long

Knitting pattern for scarf is in ribbing pattern.

PATTERN

Cast on 40 stitches in Gold.

Section A

Stitch 4 rows in Gold.

Stitch 4 rows in Red.

Stitch 4 rows in Green.

Stitch 4 rows in Blue.

Stitch 4 rows in Purple.

Now continue on in Black until scarf measures 5 feet and 8 inches.

Section B

Stitch 4 rows in Purple.

Stitch 4 rows in Blue.

Stitch 4 rows in Green.

Stitch 4 rows in Red.

Stitch 4 rows in Gold.

Cast off.

Approximate Cost of Material: Needles \$4/Wool for first scarf \$30
or multiple scarves for \$5



Purple: The darkness of sin
Blue: The hope we find in God's love
Green: The new life we experience in Jesus
Red: The blood of Jesus on the cross
Gold: The promise of eternal life through Jesus
